For the first time in 22 years, we had to cancel Alice In Winterland I know this was very disappointing to a lot of fisherman and families who like to attend. Last year over 700 registration tickets were sold. We had hoped to hold the event up to the middle of the week prior. After drilling holes, talking to fisherman and considering the tight concentration of people during the final ticket drawing at the end, it was decided that safety was our first priority. The ice thickness varied at different locations and the ice was honeycombed in spots. Some areas also had a lot of water and slush beneath the snow. Almost no fishing tournaments were held in the area this year for the same reasons. The option of setting up at one of the boat landings was evaluated, but none were large enough to hold our trailers or had enough room for the crowd that gathers.

We did hold the cash raffle drawing at Bottoms Up Bar and Grill the day of the event. This was never done before so we weren't sure how well it would be attended. The support was great and the bar was full. We made over \$5,000 dollars between pre-event ticket sales and sales at the bars. A big thanks to all who bought tickets! A big part of our profit was made possible by, Jim Bird, who won first place in the raffle. He donated it back to the Lake Alice Association. Thank you very much!

In addition, it was brought to our attention that two local neighbors and family groups had their own little fishing tournament and donated the money to the Lake Association. One was a group from Shorewood Circle headed up by Larry Roper and Steve Blixt. The other was organized by Andy Wiese and Nate Mayday. Together they donated \$400 to the Lake Association. What a great bunch of people!

I would also like to thank all of those who again donated prizes and money. It will be put toward Alice in Winterland next year.

Other people who we give thanks to are Kay Sigl for the caramel corn and cookies she sold at Rivers Edge bar. Matt Koreen for the beautiful wood furniture he made and the members who donated booze bottles.
